WALLEYE WEEKEND MILLION DOLLAR HOLE-IN-ONE GETS BIG WINNER AT CAMELOT

(5/26/09)- The Walleye Weekend Million Dollar Hole-In-One contest got its first hole-in-one of the year over Memorial Day weekend at The Golf Club at Camelot. Craig Hammann of West Bend, who was the very first golfer of the day, sunk a hole-in-one for the first time in his life and qualified for the chance at four great prizes at the final round at Walleye Weekend.

“It’s always exciting when you get someone who sinks a hole-in-one at the qualifying rounds,” said Sue Goral, one of the chairpersons of the Million Dollar Hole-In-One and representative of Blueline Family Ice Center. “It was a great start to the rest of the day of qualifying.”

As the big winner for the day, Hammann won a foursome of golf at The Golf Club at Camelot. He also received four general admission tickets for the 2009 IndyCar Pole Day, four tickets for the 2009 IndyCar Sunday Race and four 2009 IndyCar Pit and Paddock Passes.

In addition to sending Hammann to the final round for his hole-in-one shot, there was another daily qualifier that was closest to the pin for the rest of the day. Dallas Diener, who landed 2’ ¾” from the hole, will also be moving on to the final shootout at Walleye Weekend on Sunday, June 14 at 3:00 p.m.

“What a great opportunity for Craig that he gets his first hole-in-one ever and it gives him the chance to win some great prizes at Walleye Weekend,” said Mary Ann Dilling, executive

director of Fond du Lac Festivals, Inc. “Being our first time out at Camelot, we were happy to see a brand new participant to the event make a hole-in-one.”

All the qualifiers at the final round will be shooting at four holes for the chance to win a 2009 Candy Apple Red Mustang GT Coupe, an eight day Hawaiian Cruise for two, a 2009 Black F-150 SuperCrew FX4, or one million dollars. If no one sinks a hole-in-one at the final round, the closes to the pin will receive a 2009 Yar-Craft 1785 Back Troller with a Mercury Marine 75 hp OptiMax engine equipped with the new big tiller handle. The second closest to the pin will receive a \$1000 voucher for airfare provided by Travel Leaders.
